Public Hearing and Resolution No. 3655 Affirming Eligibility for and Declaring the City's Election to Receive State Shared Revenues

Requested Council Action and Suggested Motion:

Hold public hearing and take public testimony regarding Resolution No. 3655.
Move to approve Resolution No. 3655 affirming eligibility for and declaring the City's election to receive State Shared Revenues.

Public Purpose, Community Outcome, and Strategic Plan Alignment:

As required by Oregon law, each year the City Council holds a public hearing to allow comments from the community regarding the budget and the relationship of Oregon revenue sharing funds to the budget. The fiscal year 2025/26 proposal for State Revenue Sharing is to receipt funds into the General Fund to support services provided to the community.

The City Council has the final responsibility for allocating the State Shared Revenues to the programs or departments of the City. This authority is part of the responsibility given to the governing body to adopt the budget and to make appropriations by which the budget is administered (ORS 294.456).

Background:

State Revenue Sharing Law, ORS 221.770, requires cities to hold two public hearings and pass a resolution electing to receive shared funds. The first public hearing was held by the Gresham Budget Committee on April 17, 2025, prior to the budget being approved on April 29, 2025. This second hearing is to be held by City Council prior to budget adoption. Consideration of the resolution follows this public hearing. As required by Oregon law, each year the City Council considers a resolution to affirm eligibility for and declare the City's election to receive Oregon Revenue Sharing Funds.

Recommendation and Alternatives:**Recommendation:**

Staff recommends that Council move to approve Resolution No. 3655 affirming eligibility for and declaring the City's election to receive State Shared Revenues.

Alternatives:

Council may choose not to adopt Resolution No. 3655 which would result in the City not being eligible to receive State Shared Revenues budgeted at \$3,391,000.

Budget/Financial Impact:

In FY 2025/26 the General Fund is budgeted to receive \$3,391,000 as State Shared Revenue.

Public Involvement:

Notice of the April 17, 2025, Budget Committee Hearing on State Shared Revenue was published in the Gresham Outlook on March 26, 2025.

Notice of the Hearing to adopt State Shared Revenue was published in the Gresham Outlook on May 28, 2025.
